



Empower Women Media is proud to present the highlights of the LIVE WHAT YOU BELIEVE FoRB trainings in Nigeria. We focused on a two-part strategy: 1) Media Fellowship, which culminated in a FoRB film competition & film festivals, and 2) LWYB e-course and workshops. We also equipped over a dozen fellows & partners to host their own FoRB training events in different cities and venues across the country (ie. universities, churches, hotels...). The initiative also boasted TV, news and radio coverage with 100,000 exposures.

Total Participants: 5017



This figure reflects the total number of people who enrolled the course either online or at "live events". The participants include government, business, media, academic, NGO and faith leaders. Additionally, law students and high school students were equipped.

In-Person Events: 30

Together with our fellows and partners, we hosted 28 FoRB Film Festivals and LWYB Trainings across Nigeria. The events included Christians and Muslims.

Media Fellows: 30

We carefully vetted 30 media fellows, of which 12 created innovative short films sharing the importance of Freedom of Religion and Belief. The films were screened at a dozen events.

eCourse Evaluations: 2,500
